

## Last chance to register for the congress: 30<sup>st</sup> June

### Dear ESCIF Colleagues

The ESCIF board approaches you with a special newsletter regarding the congress because registrations are low at the moment. We understand that many are reluctant to travel in these uncertain times. On the other hand the board thinks it is important to have events like the ESCIF congress where we can meet, discuss and interact. It is without saying that preventive measures will be in place. Furthermore, please be also aware that all ESCIF member organisations, which can't participate in the assembly, can authorise another delegate to vote on their behalf.

The current Corona situation is very relaxed in Switzerland and government stated that there is no reason why this should change until fall. **The current travel conditions are:**

- Persons entering from the Schengen area will no longer be required to quarantine.
- The requirement to be tested will now apply only to persons arriving by plane who have not been vaccinated or have not recovered from COVID-19.
- Contact details are required when arriving by plane.
- Switzerland is easing entry restrictions for persons arriving from third countries who can prove they have been vaccinated. The list of countries has been amended accordingly.
- It is now once again possible for third-country citizens travelling from countries such as Albania or Serbia to enter Switzerland.
